Trail Ride Sunday 5th October leaving from Beaulieu Road, Red Hill at 10am

The trail ride will leave from the bottom of the hill on Beaulieu Road, Red Hill. Park on the grass next to the orchard on the left. The ride will take you through some beautiful farmland which have the most amazing views of Westernport Bay. It will take approximately three hours to ride with no stop for lunch. BYO lunch if you wish to be eaten back at the car at the end of the ride. There are a few gravel roads but most of the ride will be on grassy equestrian trails.

This is a Level 3 ride—Gayle will be the trail ride coordinator. Contact 0418 584 900 if you are lost or late. We try and leave promptly at 10am.

Trail Ride Rating 1, 2 or 3

- **Rating 1 ride will travel no faster than walking pace. These will usually be held within the club grounds. The rides are ideal for members who have new, unfamiliar or young horses and are looking for a trail ride in company, and in an enclosed environment.**
- **Rating 2 ride will travel no faster than a trot, and will also usually take place from the club grounds, and may access the local trail and road network.**
- **Rating 3 ride will involve 3 paces - walk, trot and canter, and will usually be a location away from**
