The format of the groups will be instruction in different aspects of natural horsemanship consisting of eliminating pushiness/pulling, building confidence through safety cues, speed control and softness etc. There will be many more techniques taught during the weekend, so if you have problems with your horse and would like some help, think about coming along. For those who attended last year an advanced group will be available. Cost approx \$150.00 for the weekend. Outside riders are welcome, but club members will be given first option as numbers are limited. Fence sitters \$50 per day

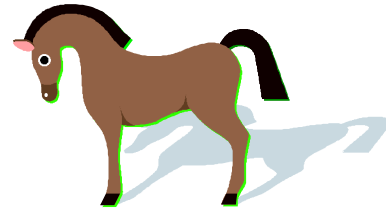
